Warm-Up Ring Steward

The job: Make sure the riders check-in with you and help them get to their designated ring on-time and in order. Make sure riders are schooling safely and following warm-up arena guidelines.

- Every rider in your ring <u>MUST</u> have a bridle number. If they do not you must send them to the office to register.
- You will be provided with an order-of-go for all arenas. Riders should check-in with you before entering the warm-up arena.
- When you see the rider put a checkmark by their number. You will probably be asked by the Ring Stewards if you have seen them.
- If you don't see a rider and it is close to their ride time, call the office to see if they have checked in. Some riders do skip the warm-up if their horse is too keyed up.
- Notify the in-gate steward for the ring they are supposed to enter that you have not seen them. They could be at the in-gate already.
- TRY TO DO—Periodically call out the order-of-go so that competitors know when they are close to their starting time. For example, "#85 is on deck, #62 is in two." You can also tell the rider..."you are after #50" and they can keep an eye on #50 and know when to head up to the ring.
- If a rider decides to scratch while in the warm-up ring, notify the steward for the ring they are supposed to enter and the office.
- Try to get the riders out of the warm-up ring and headed to their ring about 5 minutes before their ride time. When they leave the warm-up, **cross them off** your list.
- If a ring is running ahead of schedule let riders know they have the option of riding early. Riders can go before their scheduled ride time but have the right to wait until their time if they wish to.
- If the arena is running behind schedule notify the riders.
- Generally, riders are not allowed to go out of order. If there is a special circumstance and a rider needs to go out of order instruct the rider to let the scribe know.
- Lunging is only allowed in designated areas. There are lunge rings located near the Kidd Barn and behind the infield barns.
- Riders must be mounted when in the warm-up arena.
- Riders/horses jeopardizing the safety of other riders/horses may be asked to leave.
- If a rider falls the office must be notified.
- Chat with the riders be friendly help them have a pleasant experience. Most of them are new at this and very nervous.
- Call the office for drinks or emergency chocolate if needed. Have fun!
